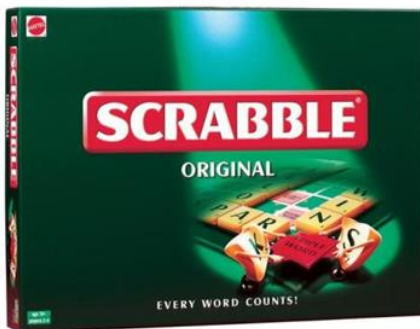

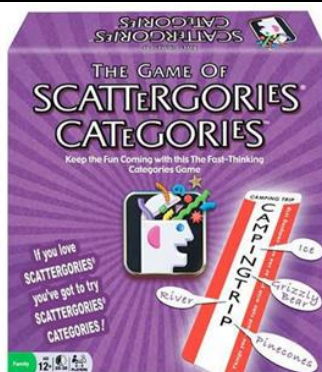
#### D1-4 Scrabble Trickster

- A word game for anyone who would try to break the original scrabble rules.
- Use trick cards to level the playing field by breaking the rules of Scrabble. Steal your opponents high score, make them lose their turn, even take advantage of a triple word score by playing a word anywhere on the board.



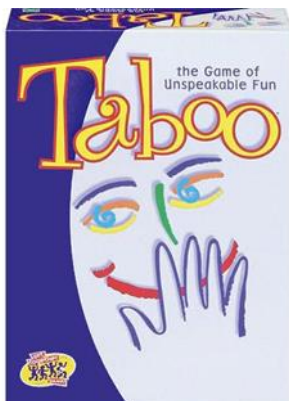
#### D1-5 Scrabble Original

- A classic word game.
- Each player must make the best use of 7 letter tiles drawn at random. Scores are given for letter values and are boosted by premium squares on the grid.



#### D1-6 The Game of Scattergories Categories

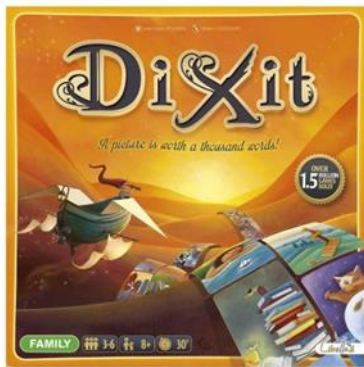
- A fast-playing, portable game of Scattergories.
- Players take a word written vertically, and brainstorm a word that starts with each letter in that word. For example if the word was FOOD, Frankfurter, Olive, Oatmeal, and Dumplings.



#### D1-7 Taboo

- A game features more than 1,000 new words.
- Classic Taboo game challenges you to guess words and phrases! You have to give creative, carefully-worded clues to get your team to guess words fast.





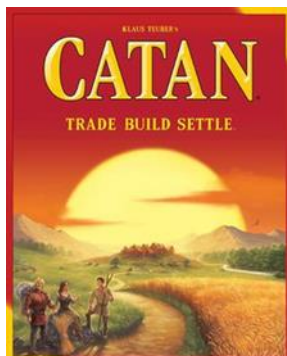
### D1-8 Dixit

- The game's title is the Latin word for "he/she/it said".
- Players select cards with various artistic pictures and match a title suggested by the "storyteller", and attempt to guess which card the "storyteller" selected.



### D1-9 Chinatown

- A negotiation game.
- Players acquire ownership of sections of city blocks then place tiles, representing businesses, onto the block-sections.



### D1-10 Catan

- It's been called the "Perfect Social Game".
- Guide your settlers to victory by trading and cunning development. Use resource combinations to buy cards and build roads, settlements, and cities.



### D1-11 Carcassonne

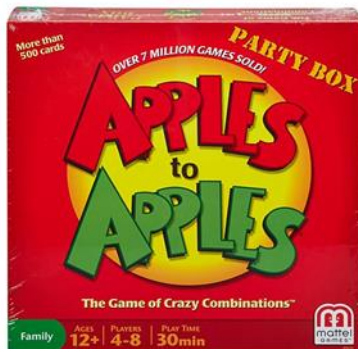
- A classic award-winning game.
- Players build the area surrounding this city. They place a follower in order to score as many points as possible. The player who will most cleverly use their followers will win the game.





### D1-12 Pandemic

- A cooperative board game and based on the premise that four diseases have broken out in the world, each threatening to wipe out a region.
- The game accommodates 2 to 4 players, each playing one of five specialists: dispatcher, medic, scientist, researcher, or operations expert.



### D1-13 Apples to Apples

- It was named "Party Game of the Year" and provides fun for 4 to 10 players.
- Select the card from your hand that you think best describes a card played by the judge. If the judge picks your card, you win that round.
