- Identify areas for improvement and engage in self-access language learning by completing tasks on academic writing pathways (content, organization, grammar, vocabulary and in-text citations/referencing skills);
- Receive language advice from your Language Advisor either face-to-face or online;
- Monitor and control your own progress of learning.
