


D1-4 Scrabble Trickster


D1-5 Scrabble Original

- A classic word game.
- Each player must make the best use of 7 letter tiles drawn at random. Scores are given for letter values and are boosted by premium squares on the grid.



D1-6 The Game of Scattergories Categories


- A fast-playing, portable game of Scattergories.
- Players take a word written vertically, and brainstorm a word that starts with each letter in that word. For example if the word was FOOD, Frankfurter, Olive, Oatmeal, and Dumplings.



D1-7 Taboo


- A game features more than 1,000 new words.
- Classic Taboo game challenges you to guess words and phrases! You have to give creative, carefully-worded clues to get your team to guess words fast.






D1-8 Dixit

- The game's title is the Latin word for "he/she/it said".
- Players select cards with various artistic pictures and match a title suggested by the "storyteller", and attempt to guess which card the "storyteller" selected.



D1-9 Chinatown

- A negotiation game.
- Players acquire ownership of sections of city blocks then place tiles, representing businesses, onto the block-sections.



D1-10 Catan

- It's been called the "Perfect Social Game".
- Guide your settlers to victory by trading and cunning development. Use resource combinations to buy cards and build roads, settlements, and cities.



D1-11 Carcassonne

- A classic award-winning game.
- Players build the area surrounding this city. They place a follower in order to score as many points as possible. The player who will most cleverly use their followers will win the game.





D1-12 Pandemic

- A cooperative board game and based on the premise that four diseases have broken out in the world, each threatening to wipe out a region.
- The game accommodates 2 to 4 players, each playing one of five specialists: dispatcher, medic, scientist, researcher, or operations expert.



D1-13 Animal Chess

- A two-player strategy game
- The player who is first to maneuver any one of their pieces into the opponent's den wins the game



D1-14 Flight Chess


- 2 - 4 players
- Each player try to get all their own plane pieces from their hangars, located at the corners of the board, into the base of their own color in the center of the board.



D1-15 Chinese Chess


- A strategy board game for 2 players
- The game represents a battle between two armies, with the object of capturing the enemy's general (king).






D1-16 Head Basket With 20 Balls

- Suitable for both indoor and outdoor play
- Attach the basket to the player's head and see how many balls can be caught




D1-17 Between Two Cities

- 3 - 7 Players (with 1 - 2 player variants)
- A partnership-driven, tile-drafting city-building game
- The player is the world-renowned city planner who has been asked to redesign two different cities. The player with the highest final score wins the game



D1-18 Sushi Go Party!

- 2 - 8 players card game
- Player must first create your own menu from a wide variety of delectable options. Then try to score the most points over three rounds by grabbing the best combination of cards



D1-19 Kingdomino

- A Strategy game with 2 - 4 players
- In the game players take turns choosing domino like tiles and adding them to their kingdoms





D1-20 Chinese checkers

- 2 - 4 or 6 players, playing individually or with partners
- Be first to race all of one's pieces across the hexagram-shaped board into "home"
